TAXPAYER IMPACT STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 551.043(c) OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE

Texas Government Code Section 551.043(c) requires that the notice of a meeting at which a governmental body will discuss or adopt its budget include a taxpayer impact statement showing, for the median-valued homestead property, a comparison of the property tax bill in dollars pertaining to the property for the current fiscal year to an estimate of the property tax bill in dollars for the same property in the upcoming fiscal year.

As required by Texas law, Weatherford College provides this statement to inform taxpayers of the potential impact of the proposed tax rate for Fiscal Year 2026-27, comparing what would be paid under the no-new-revenue tax rate versus the proposed tax rate.
