

## BEFORE YOU MEET WITH AN ADVISOR...

This list will help you be prepared for your discussion with your advisor. Review the topics on the list pertinent to your educational status.

### FIRST TIME IN COLLEGE STUDENT:

- Tell an advisor about Dual Credit Courses, AP Scores
- Have you selected a course of study?
  - Certificate
  - Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.)
  - Associate of Art (A.A.)
  - Associate of Science (A.S.)
  - Do you intend to transfer?
- Discuss your work and family life. These factors play a major role in your in the commitment of your time and realistic educational goals.
- Academic strengths/weaknesses
- Do you want to take Face to Face classes, Online only classes or a hybrid class (meeting once a week and online work the rest of the week)?
- Be sure you know how to log in to myWC. Your advisor can help, if you don't.
- Sign up for New Student Orientation, if you haven't already.

### RETURNING TO WC STUDENT:

- Discuss with your advisor your reason for stopping out.
- Have your educational goals changed?
- If your educational goals have changed, what path are you interested in taking?
- Discuss your work and family life. These factors play a major role in your in the commitment of your time and realistic educational goals.
- Do you want to take Face to Face classes, Online only classes or a hybrid class (meeting once a week and online work the rest of the week)?
- Do you know your current academic standing (good standing, probation, suspension)?

### TRANSFER STUDENT:

- Present any copies of transcripts, unofficial transcripts can be used for advising purposes.
- Discuss your reason for transfer.
- Discuss educational goals.
